What is the Seal of Arts Proficiency?

This program recognizes high school students who have demonstrated high levels of proficiency in the Arizona Arts Education Standards through personal expression and creative experiences in arts education programs at the time of graduation. Seal is placed on diploma and noted on transcript up to 90 days after graduation. Below is the documentation required to earn this seal.

Please include sufficient documentation for ALL of the following:

- ☐ A final GPA of 3.0 or 4.0 in each qualifying arts/career and technical education (CTE) course.
- ☐ 4 minimum credit requirements in one of the following ways: (see pages12-13 for list of qualifying courses)
 - ➤ a. A minimum of 4 credits in one artistic discipline: (dance, music, theatre, visual arts or media arts) OR
 - ➤ b. 3 credits in one artistic discipline, and 1 qualifying creative industries CTE credit or separate artistic discipline. OR
 - > c. 2 credits in one artistic discipline, and 2 credits in a qualifying creative industries CTE class or a separate artistic discipline.
- □ 80 hours of arts related extracurricular activities for 2023 graduates and beyond. (see pages 14 for list of qualifying activities)
 - ➤ 2021 graduates need 45 hours
 - ➤ 2022 graduates need 60 hours
- ☐ A student capstone project (see pages 16-18 for criteria)
