

Hello Orchestra Families!

Our Orchestra Booster organization is ready to start another fantastic year of great music and memories. A few of the ways we support your musician are:

- Providing funding for school instrument rental, purchases, and repairs.
- Scholarships for students as needed for trips and festival auditions.
- Funding for sheet music purchases.
- Coordinating individual and group fundraising.
- Hosting 6th Grade Festivals, ABODA Festivals, and possibly others.

- Support for Senior Recognition and our Annual Awards Banquet.
- Transportation funding.
- Website Maintenance, facilitating online purchases.
- All-State Participation Fees for students who earn a position.
- Post-concert Student Treats.
- Funding for Music Clinicians.

Uniforms are an important aspect of Orchestra performance. We provide new, annually designed t-shirts, measure for and distribute formal uniforms at the beginning of the year, and provide dry cleaning at the end of the year. We also cover the group fees for our orchestras to participate in adjudicated festivals and host at least one on-campus, fun, social event.

While fundraising helps offset these costs, we ask each student to pay an Annual Fee of \$35, due August 16th. This is separate from the fee collected by the bookstore. This can be paid by credit card on our website (CampoVerdeOrchestras.org), or by check or cash to the lock box in Mrs. Payne's office. When paying by check, please make it payable to Campo Verde Orchestra Boosters.

We have a change in our financial communication with you. CutTime (our previous student dues tracking system) changed its business model and is no longer viable for our financial tracking. We will be using a system of private Google Drive folders to show you what financial obligations and payments are associated with your child.
